

A Typical Day in Eden...

9:15-9:50 Good Morning Everyone! The children arrive to be greeted by the Eden team and guided into their morning **Literacy/Numeracy/sensory** activities or a **Movement break**.

9:50-10:15 Circle Time/PSHE/Attention Autism We come together as a group to self-register, sing and sign 'good morning' to our teachers and friends. We then enjoy a Makaton Sing and Sign session, with the children practising communication and turn taking skills.

10:15-10:30 Snack and Communication time. Focusing on using our personalised symbols and signs to communicate our needs

10:30-11:00 Outdoor time/**Intensive Interactions** (Mirroring that builds confidence and trust)

11:00-11:30 Phonics and letter of the day activities (letter formation, phonics games, picture matching)

11:30-11:55 – Musical Maths (Number or subitising focus)

12-1:30 Lunch and Outdoor play

1:30-2 Whole group learning session (This includes sessions such as art, sensory story (based around current topic/theme), science and music)

2-2:15 TACPAC/ HANDYPAC, Individual target time, 1:1 intervention time, and sensory play (sensory work to build communication and trust)

2:15-2:45 Whole group learning session (This includes sessions such as art, sensory story (based around current topic/theme), science and music)

2:45 -3:10 Snack and Communication time.

3:10- 3:30 R.E End of day Relaxation Parachute/Story/Goodbye Song

3:30 Home Time
