

Parent Progress Meetings 2020 - 2021

This is the seventh year we have been running termly Parent progress meetings, the aim of these meetings is to continue to share with parents the progress their child is making within the core areas of learning as well as their IEP targets, in addition parents and teachers have the opportunity to discuss any other matters arising. Parents are offered a face to face meeting, Teams meeting or a phone call if they would prefer. Parents are formally asked if they feel their child is making good progress as part of the meeting and in addition we also take this opportunity to ask parents if they are happy with the information communicated to them through the day2day books.
