### **Important: Heatwave Arrangements at Curnow School**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware, we are currently experiencing a period of very hot weather. At Curnow School, the safety and wellbeing of our pupils is always our top priority, and we have put additional measures in place to support everyone during this time.

In school, we are:

- \* Adapting the timetable to reduce physical activity and time outdoors (in the sun)
- \* Ensuring pupils have frequent opportunities to drink and stay hydrated
- \* Using cooler and shaded areas wherever possible
- \* Offering flexibility with clothing to keep pupils comfortable

#### **Please ensure your child comes to school with:**

- \* A water bottle (if appropriate)
- \* A sun hat or other preferred head covering
- \* Sunscreen applied before school (and sent in if required)
- \* Comfortable, lightweight clothing

As all of our pupils have individual needs, it is really important that you let us know if:

- \* Your child has been unwell or unsettled due to the heat
- \* There have been any changes to medication or health needs
- \* Your child may be more sensitive to heat than usual

We know that hot weather can be particularly challenging for many of our pupils, and we appreciate your support in helping us keep everyone safe, regulated and comfortable.
