Uniform at Curnow School consists of:

- Blue or white polo shirt
- Navy sweatshirt or cardigan (those with a school logo are available to buy from Trophy Textiles, Unit 2D, Pool Business Park, TR15 3QW. Phone: 01209 713341).
- Black or Grey trousers, skirts, pinafore or shorts
- Plain Black Shoes
- Some students choose to wear blue and white checked school dresses during the warmer months

The wearing of school uniform is discretionary. We fully understand that some students prefer not to wear a uniform and we respect their individuality. If any part of the uniform is difficult to tolerate, for example school trousers, please feel free to substitute this part of the uniform for a more comfortable alternative.

Pupils can also wear uniform without the school logos; these can be purchased in a variety of supermarkets and stores from £1.25 for polo shirts and from £2.50 for jumpers.

Some parents donate good quality worn items to school once their child grows out of them. Please let the class teacher know if you would like to access these or feel free to send in items that are no longer worn. This way we can all support each other with the cost of uniform. - All items of clothing must be clearly marked with your child's name.
