

Learning in Fistral Class

A typical day in Fistral:

- 9.00am -9.30am Arrive at school into Circle Time for Communication, Speaking & Listening - Good Morning and use our –Pre-Reading Skills to choose our lunch – get ready for learning – chair yoga & handwashing
- 9.30am- 10.15am Maths, Cognition & Learning based Skills and Physical Therapy activities small group & 1:1 support,
- ▶ 10.15am-11.00am Snack, hand washing and teeth cleaning followed by Outdoor Play (PHSE) whole group with 1:1 supervision/support as required
- 11.00am-11.30am Literacy & Communication Based Skills such as Write Dance, Disco Dough, Sounds and Object Bingo, Sensory Story, Who's in the Bag - Phonics
- 11.30am-12.00pm Whole Group Movement session in the hall such as Therapy Ball Session, Equipment, Dance, Skittles, Yoga, Sound Bath
- ▶ 12.00pm-12.15pm What's in the Bucket?— Attention Session
- 12.15pm-1.30pm Lunch and Outdoor Play (Communication targets/PHSE) with whole class, 1:1 supervision/support as required
- ▶ 1.30pm-1.50pm Whole Group -Mindfulness Session
- ▶ **1.50pm-2.30pm** Afternoon Topic based Lesson Sensory Journey, TACPAC, Cooking, Art and Musical Exploration, Science, DT.
- 2.30pm 2.50pm Snack (communication & PHSE) whole group
- 2.50pm-3.15pm Class Celebration, Curnow Code Tokens, Dojo Points., short term targets celebrate learning (RE & SMSC)
