






Some of us have been working on our visual targets. We practice looking up, down, left and right. We are very good at tracking and some of us have started to smile at ourselves in the mirror.








MONTHLY CORE WORD

This month's focus words are in and out.






Ideas for using key words in cooking - Make some cupcakes or biscuits. Can you put **in** the flour? Take the cakes




We will be holding a parent coffee morning on Monday 15th November at 9.30am at Lower School. We are really lucky to be hosting Michelle from the Parent Carer


